What is Skill M&E?

Skill M&E is four skills competitions that search for the best of the best mechanical and electrical engineers from the building services engineering sector. Skill M&E is organised by SummitSkills, the sector skills council for the building services engineering sector.

The four separate skills competitions cover the following occupational areas:

Electrical Installation (SkilleLECTRIC)

Refrigeration & Air Conditioning (SkillFRIDGE)

Pipe Fitting (SkillPIPE)

Plumbing (SkillPLUMB)

SkilleLECTRIC, SkillFRIDGE, SkillPLUMB and SkillPIPE have been designed to promote standards and skills across the sector, developing competence into excellence. There are opportunities to compete locally, regional and nationally across the UK.

At these events competitors will undertake a series of practical tests based on real-life work, which will demonstrate their abilities and highlight their outstanding skills in their industry.

Winners of the competitions also could have the chance to become truly world-class at WorldSkills, the largest international skills competition in the world. The next WorldSkills event will be held in London in 2011.

Who is Skill M&E for?

Skill M&E is open to people who have gained, or are gaining vocational skills in plumbing, refrigeration, electrical installation and pipe fitting. In keeping with the main routes into employment, most competitors will be apprentices, college students, trainees and/or employees.

Why should I sponsor a Skill M&E competition?

There are many advantages in sponsoring one or more of the skills competitions that SummitSkills organises under the umbrella of Skill M&E. A few of the key incentives of becoming a sponsor are:

What are the different types of sponsorship packages?

All levels of financial commitment will be considered, although we have created the following sponsorship packages:

Competition sponsor – premier package

Cost £20,000 + VAT

There will be a maximum of four premier sponsors, one for each of the skills competitions (SkillELECTRIC, SkillFRIDGE, SkillPLUMB and SkillPIPE).

Benefits include:

- Opportunity to provide equipment or products which competitors should use in the competition
- Eight VIP places to attend the UK skills competition final
- Photograph of key company representative with winners
- Opportunity to have promotional literature at the awards event
- Recognition in skills competition press releases issued after the UK finals

- Opportunity to provide a venue for the UK Final

Competition sponsor – standard package

Cost £10,000 + VAT

There will be a maximum of two sponsors for each of the skills competitions (SkillELECTRIC, SkillFRIDGE, SkillPLUMB and SkillPIPE).

Benefits include:

- Logo to appear in communication materials related to the competition, e.g. invitation letter, event programme etc.
- Opportunity to have a promotional banner at the competition
- Add your logo on the Skill M&E website (www.skillMandE.org.uk) and reciprocal link to your own site
- Four VIP places to attend a national skills competition and award ceremony
- Opportunity to offer prizes to winners, including training, products or services
- Use of Skill M&E logo for your company letterhead/website

- Use of photographs taken at events for your promotional and PR purposes

- Check on performance and put benchmarks in place

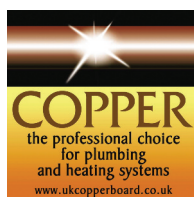
